

## ICABS2007 Call for Proposals on Invited Business/Industry Sessions

2007 SIWN International Conference on Adaptive Business Systems (ICABS'2007) invites Proposals on Invited Business/Industry Sessions. Anyone who is interested in organizing Invited Business/Industry Sessions at ICABS2007 should submit a proposal to the relevant program co- chairs at the addresses below.

### Scope

ICABS2007 is interested in proposals for Invited Business/Industry Sessions at the leading edge of technologies in research and development of complex open distributed systems particularly related to one of the 12 themes of the conference, i.e.:

Track 1 Enterprise Systems (in perspectives of information, management, organization, automation, etc.)

Track 2 Enterprise Collaboration

Track 3 Supply Chains and Logistics

Track 4 E-Business

Track 5 Business Intelligence

Track 6 On-Demand Businesses

Track 7 Industrial Applications of Multi-Agent Systems

Track 8 Information Infrastructures of Businesses

Track 9 Self-Organization and Emergence

### Submission Requirements for Invited Business/Industry Sessions

In general the relevant Program Co-chairs need to be satisfied with the quality with respect to the tentative invited papers and the fitness of the topic within the conference program as a whole. Factors to be considered also include: relevance, timeliness, and importance of the topic.

The proposed chair(s) of an invited session will be responsible to the consolidation of the papers to be presented in the session, and to the acceptance of papers. Papers accepted by the chair of an invited session will be published in the conference proceedings as invited papers.

The proposal should follow the structure of below.

#### (1) Title

The title of the invited session, and the name and affiliation of the session organizer (and thus the chair of the invited session at the Conference).

#### (2) Topic and scope

A brief statement of the topic and scope of the session, and its relevance, timeliness and importance to the theme of the conference. Also there should be a brief description about the cohesion among the invited papers to be included in the invited session.

#### (3) Tentative list of invited papers

Give a list of minimum 3 papers to be invited tentatively and for each of the papers, provide the following.

- Name, affiliation, postal address, e-mail address, URL of personal homepage (if any) of authors;
- Author's short bio (100-150 words);
- A brief statement on the relationship of the paper to the topic of the invited session;
- Full length manuscripts of the invited papers (Once the proposal is accepted, all papers must be ready by the deadline for camera-ready-versions of the Conference.).

It is not required that all authors of the proposed papers have to be from industry or business, but it is important that the proposed invited session should address a clearly defined problem that is of practical significance for industry or business. It is particularly welcomed that the invited session discusses real-world industry or business problems.

#### (4) Session organizer (thus the chair)

Give the following information of the session's organizer, who will also chair the invited session at the conference.

- Name, affiliation, postal address, e-mail address, URL of personal homepage (if any)
- Short bio (100-150 words)
